SUBJECT: Appropriation Modification South County Child Advocacy Center

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Consider recommendations relating to South County Child Advocacy Center.

Possible action:

- a. Approve establishment of Capital Improvement Project No. 263-CP24034, “South County Child Advocacy Center.”
- b. Approve Request for Appropriation Modification No. 189 - \$1,000,000 transferring funds from the Accumulated Capital Outlay Fund and the Office of the District Attorney budget to Capital Project No. 263-CP24034, “South County Child Advocacy Center,” relating to supporting the planning and design work associated with the project. (4/5 Vote)

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Funds required for the project augmentation will be transferred from the District Attorney’s Office Budget and the Fiscal Year 2023-24 Accumulated Capital Outlay Fund to Capital Project No. 263-CP24034 “South County Child Advocacy Center.”

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION AND BACKGROUND

Funding is required to engage the architectural/engineering team so it can initiate site investigations, assess the current building conditions, and prepare construction documents for submission to the building department for permit approval. The Facilities and Fleet Department (FAF) will proceed with the bidding process and awarding the construction project upon obtaining the permit.

The recommended action would have a positive impact on the children and youth through the **Youth Feel Valued by the Community** indicator as the South County Child Advocacy Center will provide needed services to children in the community.
