**WHEREAS**, the County of Santa Clara wishes to honor and reflect on the histories and traditions of the AAPI community and how the Asian-Pacific experience has helped shape American history, culture, and identity;

**WHEREAS**, the AAPI community has made significant contributions to the growth and development of the United States economy and culture, from the first landing of Filipinos on contiguous American soil in 1587, to Chinese immigrants contributing to create the nation's first transcontinental railroad, to brave servicemembers who made the ultimate sacrifice to protect the nation during times of war, to modern day achievements in arts and culture, science, technology, engineering, and math with more than 60 Nobel Prize winners;

**WHEREAS**, during National Asian American Pacific Islander Heritage Month, the County of Santa Clara honors the perseverance of those who courageously reached for their hopes and dreams in a new land;

**WHEREAS**, the Asian Pacific Islander Employee Committee (APIEC) of Santa Clara County Social Services Agency is hosting the SSA API Heritage Month to celebrate "Legacies of Hope," on Wednesday, May 8, 2024; and,

**WHEREAS**, the County of Santa Clara wishes to recognize and celebrate the many contributions and achievements of the AAPI community in local business, technology, agriculture, academia, medicine, government, and the arts.
