

- WHEREAS,** Alyssa Lynch is celebrating her retirement following 11 years of service as Superintendent of the Metropolitan Education District (MetroED), which operates the Silicon Valley CTE Center, the largest career technical education center in Northern California, and Silicon Valley Education Adult Education, for six school districts in Santa Clara County;
- WHEREAS,** Alyssa's remarkable 30-year career in education includes working for the Santa Clara County Office of Education for nine years and the Mission Valley Regional Occupational Program for 11 years;
- WHEREAS,** Alyssa holds a bachelor's and master's degree in Home Economics & Fashion from California State University, Fresno, and San Francisco State University, respectively; and a teaching credential, administrative services credential, and master's degree in Educational Leadership from San José State University;
- WHEREAS,** Alyssa's passion for career technical education is evident in her skillful and successful leadership as she paved the way for MetroED's conversion from direct state funding to the Local Control Funding Formula, including securing more than \$15 million in grant funding, and started programs in response to the labor market, such as courses in Electrical Vehicles/Automotive Services and Nursing Careers, and Alyssa has been active with local rotaries, including San José Chamber of Commerce, Work2Future, and Santa Clara County School Boards Association; and
- WHEREAS,** Alyssa's 11 years of leadership and 30 years in career technical education have had an enormously positive impact on the young adults of our region.
