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# 2024 Eligibility Prioritization

- Priority 1: Youth in foster care, kinship care, or adopted.
- Priority 2: All youth served by DFCS with open cases, and/or referred to the Differential Response Program.
- Priority 3: Low-income youth - capped at 15% of total referrals.
  - Limited to two camps or activities per youth
  - Scholarships average around \$800 to \$900 for foster, kinship or adoptive and \$600 for low-income

*\*Registration opened to foster, adoptive, and kinship youth and youth receiving DFCS services on March 13, 2024.*

*\*\*Registration for youth who are only eligible through low income opened on April 24, 2024.*



# 2024 Outreach & Marketing Efforts

- Completed flier - English, Spanish & Vietnamese
- Flier distributed to DFCS foster parents, Foster Family Agencies and KAFPA Members
- Memo & Flier - sent to DFCS Staff
  - Presented at DFCS All Staff meeting
- Summer Camp Resource Fair held on March 2, 2024
  - 40 caregivers attended
  - 14 organizations participated
- KAFPA worked with camps to arrange for free and low cost multi-day or overnight camps
- Efforts made to increase camps/activities for older youth
