**WHEREAS,** Solaire Apartments is located in close proximity to public transportation, including Diridon Station, which will allow the residents to have easy access to the many surrounding amenities; and

**WHEREAS,** Solaire Apartments would not have come to fruition without the support of the County of Santa Clara Measure A Affordable Housing Bond and the project's local, state, and federal elected representatives, and Eden Housing's partners.
