WHEREAS, Solaire Apartments will provide homes to households that are in threat of being priced out of the housing market but are essential to a strong and diverse community, including the lower-income workforce and individuals and families who have experienced homelessness in the past;

WHEREAS, Solaire Apartments is located in close proximity to public transportation, including Diridon Station, which will allow the residents to have easy access to the many surrounding amenities; and

WHEREAS, Solaire Apartments would not have come to fruition without the support of the County of Santa Clara Measure A Affordable Housing Bond and the project's local, state, and federal elected representatives, and Eden Housing's partners.


