Parisi House on the Hill Video Security Cameras

Annual Surveillance Report: July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023

1. DESCRIPTION OF HOW THE SURVEILLANCE TECHNOLOGY WAS USED

The County of Santa Clara Health System Surveillance Use Policy (SUP) for Parisi House on the Hill Video Security Cameras (PHTOH) at Behavioral Health Services Department (BHSD) facility will be used to increase the security and protection of the facilities, residents, staff, visitors, and the public. The Parisi House on the Hill (PHTOH) residential center is a residential treatment facility and has been operated by a contractor.

The video security camera will include five exterior digital cameras at the PHTOH residential center located at 9505 Malech in San Jose, and it will allow the County and contracted agency to maintain public safety and the identification, assessment, investigation, and reporting of behavior or activity that reasonably appears to be unauthorized, in violation of Department or County policy, illegal, or in furtherance of illegal activity.

The PHTOH Video Security Cameras technology has not been implemented at the facility yet pending an update to the SUP.

7. ANNUAL COSTS

- Hardware (Camera and Recorder): \$29,400
- Maintenance/Support: \$212
- Application Administrator: \$50,000

The source of funding is from Budget Unit 412, which is Behavioral Health Services Department.
