**Full Body Security Scanners**  
**Annual Surveillance Report: July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023**

**1. DESCRIPTION OF HOW THE TECHNOLOGY WILL BE USED**

During this reporting period, the Sheriff's Office used Full-Body Security Screeners. These devices (Model: Soter RS) are manufactured by OD Security North America. These devices are currently installed at Main Jail and Elmwood.

The Full-Body Security Scanners were used to prevent or detect contraband, drugs, weapons, and potential weapons from entering or remaining within the confines of our correctional facilities. This technology enhanced the security and safety for inmates, visitors, and employees at the Santa Clara County jails.

**2. DATA SHARING WITH OUTSIDE ENTITIES**

No data was shared with outside entities.

**3. COMMUNITY COMPLAINTS OR CONCERNS**

Any community complaints regarding the use of this equipment are routed to Lt. Sugey Jaimez in Internal Affairs for tracking and response.

The Sheriff's Office did not receive any complaints or concerns from members of the community regarding Full-Body Security Scanners.

**4. NON-PRIVELEGED INTERNAL AUDITS/POLICY VIOLATIONS**

All Sheriff's Office staff are provided the Surveillance Use Polices, via an internal web-based portal requiring review and a completed attestation of acknowledgement.

Oversight of the Facility Administrative Sergeants occurs for the usage of Full-Body Security Scanners through online training and certification. This equipment was used within the parameters of the Surveillance Use Policy and there were no allegations or findings of policy violations related to the Custody Bureau's Safety and Security Equipment.

There is no evidence to suggest that this technology was used disproportionately affecting lower-income community members or community members of color.

**5. EFFECTIVENESS IN ACHIEVING ITS IDENTIFIED PURPOSE**

This equipment has been effective and has achieved its intended use to detect images within the human body in the prevention of introducing contraband into the jail facilities.

The Full Body Security Scanner has proven its purpose in the detection of contraband.
