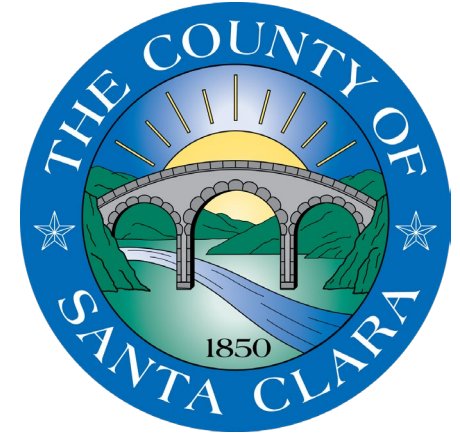

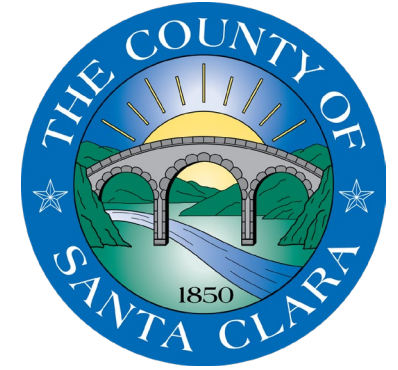

# The Welcoming Center



## ***Location***

Continue to review properties that may be suitable for the DFCS Welcoming Center.

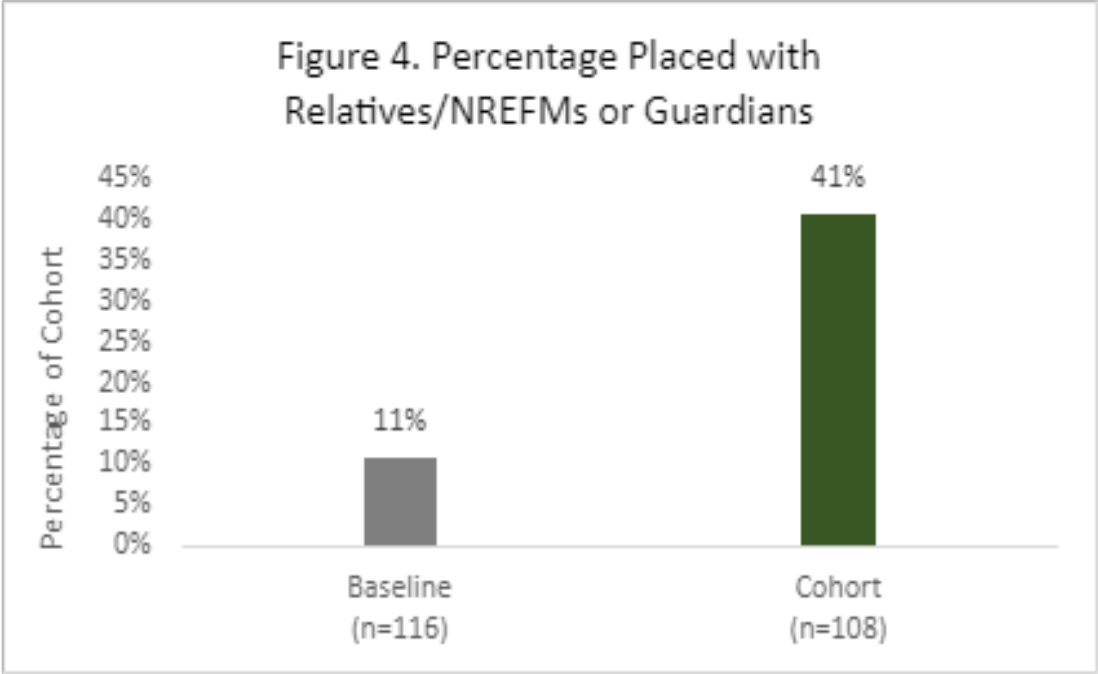
## ***Transition Timeline***

Resubmitted Transitional Shelter Care Facility (TSCF) license application with Community Care Licensing (CCL) requesting additional revisions on November 13.

## **September-December 2023**

- Finalize licensure process - request for technical assistance from CCL
- Interviewing SSPM (Group Home Administrator) & Management Analyst (Facility Manager)
- Complete any possible facility updates - fire inspection on 11/28/23
- Staff completed Therapeutic Crisis Intervention (TCI) certifications and recertifications in October & November

# Evaluation



Of all children recently entering care, a higher rate were placed with relatives and NREFMs in Q3 2023 compared to the Q3 2022

Comparisons between the Welcoming Center Baseline and Cohort Groups		
	Baseline (Welcoming Center)	Cohort (Welcoming Center)
Children/Youth		
Total number of children who stayed in the facility	49 children	48 children
Overstay in the Facility		
Percentage of children who overstayed	18%	29%

For the Baseline group, 18% experienced overstays awaiting placement. In the Cohort group, 29% experienced overstays

# The Welcoming Center



## Evaluation & Next Steps

**Crosssectional study** comparing children who entered care in 2012 to those who entered in 2017 and those who entered in 2022

- Data analyzed 12 months after entry to care to see if:
  - increased homebased family care
  - decreased congregate care placement
  - expedited permanency

## Programmatic Context

- Establish in-county Short-Term Residential Therapeutic program (STRTP) in collaboration with BHSD and CBOs
- Increase and effectively utilize ISFC+ beds
- Identification and delivery of aftercare services
- Build Child Adolescent Needs and Services (CANS) assessment capacity
- License scattered sites as TSCFs
