FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There is no impact to the General Fund as a result of the recommended actions.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION AND BACKGROUND

The Board of Supervisors is the governing body for all county offices and measures as well as for Judges of the Superior Court. California Elections Code Section 15372 requires the elections official to prepare a certified statement of the results of the election and submit it to the governing body within 30 days of the election. The deadline for county elections officials to certify their results to their governing body is April 4, 2024.

Additionally, California Elections Code Section 15400 requires the governing body to declare elected or nominated to each office voted on, at each election under its jurisdiction, the person having the highest number of votes for that office. At a primary election, pursuant to California Elections Code Section 8140, a candidate for a "vote for one" nonpartisan office

who receives a majority of votes on all ballots cast shall be elected to that office; whereas, pursuant to California Elections Code Section 8141, if no candidate has been elected to a “vote for one” office, then the candidates nominated for that office to be on the ballot in the general election will be the candidates receiving the two highest numbers of votes.
